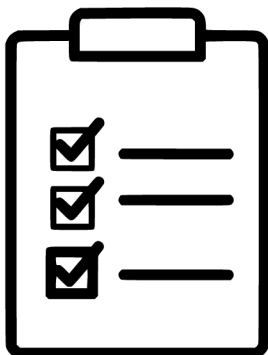


SIGNS YOUR CHILD MAY NEED A SPEECH EVALUATION:

- You have difficulty understanding him/her.
- You or other caregivers are the only people who understand him/her.
- He/she is replacing consonant or vowel sounds with incorrect sounds.
- His/her speech sounds like “baby talk” even though they are older.
- You and/or your child become frustrated during communication tasks.
- He/she continues to babble after 2 years of age.
- He/she has difficulty moving their lips and/or tongue to form speech sounds.
- He/she has a limited vocabulary and trouble pronouncing new words.
- He/she consistently struggles to connect letters with sounds and sounds with letters.
- You are concerned about his/her speech and language development but are unsure if they have a speech and language delay.



If your child is over the age of 2 and you are concerned about any of the signs above, consider a speech evaluation to determine the need for speech therapy.
